We use the natural sound of the guitar to ease open the windows of imagination and creativity. The unique features of each song are explained briefly to offer a platform upon which fundamentals of musical awareness may be layered. Featured styles include flamenco, danza puertorriqueña, vals, cumbia, pasodoble, and other typical rhythms from a variety of Latin music traditions. Spanish phrases are utilized as they pertain to music elements and the theme or title of a piece. Lisa y Josué's creative multicultural approach allows for the inclusion of other music, such as Calypso, Country/Western, Jewish, Irish, Italian or as appropriate for a holiday program or heritage month celebration. Since the material is guitar-driven, children learn where the guitar can take them -- not only to different parts of world, but also to a different mindset. Our goal is to encourage openness, the imagination, and spark musical curiosity as the level of interactive participation builds throughout the show. However, it all starts with careful listening, since the guitar is not a loud instrument.
